#### Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Draft Beer for Off-Site Consumption in Damascus MC 12-21

This bill authorizes the Montgomery County Board of License Commissioners to issue a refillable or nonrefillable container permit for draft beer to the holder of a Class H beer and wine license if the licensed premises is in Damascus (12th election district). The bill also makes conforming changes. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2021.** 

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Montgomery County can issue the permits and handle any enforcement activities with existing resources. Montgomery County revenues are not affected.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

# **Analysis**

**Current Law:** The board may issue a refillable or nonrefillable container permit for draft beer to the holder of (1) a Class B beer and wine license; (2) a Class D beer and wine license; or (3) a Class BD-BWL license. There is no annual license fee for a refillable or nonrefillable container permit in Montgomery County.

Class H licenses generally authorize the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages at a hotel or restaurant at the place described in the license for on-premises consumption. The annual license fee is \$400.
