Senate Bill 933 Finance (Senator Benson)

**Economic Matters** 

#### Financial Regulation - Access to Banking and Financial Services - Reporting

This bill requires the Office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation (OCFR) to submit a report to the General Assembly, by December 31, 2021, analyzing the banking environment in Maryland. The report must (1) include the number and types of State and federal banks and other financial institutions by jurisdiction; (2) identify banking deserts in the State where citizens have limited access to financial services or are living in areas without a credit union or bank branch; and (3) recommend strategies to ensure residents of underserved jurisdictions have access to financial services. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2021.** 

#### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** OCFR can likely prepare the required report with existing resources. Revenues are not affected.

### Analysis

**Current Law:** OCFR (within the Maryland Department of Labor) is responsible for chartering and regulating State-chartered banks, credit unions, and other types of financial institutions.
