



Number of Daily Vaccine Doses Administered



Ratio of 1st to 2nd Doses




Comparing COVID-19 New Cases and Number of Deaths




1st and 2nd Doses based on State Population






State Comparison: % of Doses Unused to Doses Delivered






State Comparison of 1st Doses Administered






% of Population 65 + to % of Population with 1st Dose




% of Population Identified as White Alone to % of Population with 1st Dose




% of Population Identified as Black or African American Alone to % of Population with 1st Dose




% of Population Identified as Hispanic to % of Population with 1st Dose





JOHNSON & JOHNSON

- Following federal guidance to make J&J available to <u>all</u> communities
- We will receive 49,600 initial doses of J&J, and we are distributing it across all providers.
- Note that this is an <u>initial</u> allocation.



EXPANDING ACCESS

- The COVID-19 vaccination support center has now booked 26,714 appointments
- PrepMod upgrade for counties will be in place this week
- Pre-registration is on track to launch by mid-March.


