AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "**Positions**—" and substitute "**Board Members and**"; in line 3, after the first "of" insert "<u>increasing the number of members of the Maryland State Board of Contract Appeals; clarifying the number of Appeals Board members required for an appeal;"; in the same line, strike "Maryland State Board of Contract Appeals" and substitute "<u>Appeals Board</u>"; in line 5, in each instance, after "of" insert "<u>staff</u>"; in line 6, after "year;" insert "<u>providing for the expiration of the initial terms of certain members of the Appeals Board;</u>"; in the same line, after the first "the" insert "<u>members and</u>"; and in line 10, after "Section" insert "<u>15—207 and</u>".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 15, insert:

"15–207.

- (a) (1) The Appeals Board consists of [3] 6 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (2) AN APPEAL BEFORE THE APPEALS BOARD SHALL BE HEARD BY A PANEL OF NOT MORE THAN 3 MEMBERS DESIGNATED BY THE CHAIRMAN.
 - (b) Each member of the Appeals Board shall:
 - (1) be qualified to serve in a quasi-judicial capacity; and
 - (2) <u>have a thorough knowledge of procurement practices and processes.</u>

- (c) Before taking office, each appointee to the Appeals Board shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.
 - (d) (1) The term of a member is 5 years.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Appeals Board on October 1, 1988.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
 - (e) The Governor may remove a member of the Appeals Board for cause.".

On page 2, after line 16, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding § 15–207(d) of the State Finance and Procurement Article, the initial terms of the 3 additional members appointed to the Maryland State Board of Contract Appeals in accordance with § 15–207(a) of the State Finance and Procurement Article, as enacted by this Act, shall expire as follows:

- (1) one member in 2024;
- (2) one member in 2025; and
- (3) one member in 2027.";

and in line 17, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
