IN THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL MENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST" MEANS: (A) **(1)** A SCHOOL COUNSELOR;

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
