F12lr0653 HB 138/21 – W&M (PRE-FILED) By: Delegate Johnson Requested: October 6, 2021 Introduced and read first time: January 12, 2022 Assigned to: Ways and Means A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT concerning Education - Sexual Abuse and Assault Awareness and Prevention Program - Human and Sex Trafficking FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education and certain nonpublic schools to develop and implement a program of age-appropriate education on the awareness and prevention of sexual abuse and assault that includes, for students in certain grades, material promoting the awareness and prevention of human and sex trafficking; and generally relating to human and sex trafficking awareness and prevention programs in public and nonpublic schools. BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 7-439 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7-439.In this section, "nonpublic school" means a noncollegiate educational (a) institution that: Holds a certificate of approval from the State Board under § 2–206(e) of (1) this article: and (2)Participates in the Nonpublic Schools Textbook and Technology Grants

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- 2 (b) (1) The State Board and each nonpublic school in the State shall develop 3 and implement a program of age-appropriate education on the awareness and prevention 4 of sexual abuse and assault.
- 5 (2) The program required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall [be]:
- 6 (i) [Taught] **BE TAUGHT** by a teacher who is trained to provide 7 instruction on the awareness and prevention of sexual abuse and assault; [and]
- 8 (ii) [Incorporated] **BE INCORPORATED** into the health curriculum 9 of each county board and each nonpublic school; **AND**
- 10 (III) INCLUDE, FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 8, 11 MATERIAL PROMOTING THE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN AND SEX 12 TRAFFICKING.
- 13 (c) The State Board shall adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 16 1, 2022.
