

- 4 (2) The president of the county board is entitled to receive:
- 5 (i) \$29,000 annually as compensation; or
- 6 (ii) An annual salary set through legislation based on the 7 recommendations of the Montgomery County Board of Education Compensation 8 Commission in accordance with Title 28, Subtitle 1A of the Local Government Article.
- 9 (3) An elected member is entitled to health insurance and to other fringe 10 benefits regularly provided to employees of the board of education under the same terms 11 and conditions extended to other employees of the board of education.
- 12 (c) (1) The student member may not receive compensation but, after submitting expense vouchers, may be reimbursed for out—of—pocket expenses incurred in connection with official duties.
- 15 (2) (I) A student member who completes a full term on the county board 16 shall be granted a scholarship [of:
- 17 (i) \$5,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education costs; $18 \,$ or
- 19 (ii) A scholarship set through legislation based on the 20 recommendations of the Montgomery County Board of Education Compensation 21 Commission in accordance with Title 28, Subtitle 1A of the Local Government Article] TO 22 BE APPLIED TOWARD THE STUDENT'S HIGHER EDUCATION COSTS.
- (II) THE SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT IS EQUAL TO THE HIGHEST
 ANNUAL RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE TUITION, MANDATORY FEES, AND ROOM AND
 BOARD THAT IS CHARGED AT A 4-YEAR PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
 WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND, OTHER THAN THE UNIVERSITY OF
 MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS AND UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE
 CAMPUS, FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR IN WHICH THE STUDENT MEMBER SERVES ON
 THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 31 1, 2022.
