- 1 (B) (1) THE AUTHORITY SHALL REQUIRE ANY PERSON WHO APPLIES TO 2 ESTABLISH AN E-ZPASS ACCOUNT TO AGREE TO ABIDE BY TERMS AND CONDITIONS 3 ESTABLISHED BY THE AUTHORITY FOR THE ELECTRONIC COLLECTION OF TOLLS.
- 4 (2) THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR E-ZPASS ACCOUNTS SHALL 5 ALLOW A PERSON TO DISPUTE ANY CHARGE OR FEE WITHIN AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER 6 THE CHARGE OR FEE IS POSTED TO THE PERSON'S E-ZPASS ACCOUNT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2022.
