### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 University of Maryland – Institute for Public Leadership – Establishment

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Institute for Public Leadership at the University of
  Maryland, College Park Campus; and generally relating to the Institute for Public
  Leadership at the University of Maryland.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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## Article – Education

14 **13–105.** 

15 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "INSTITUTE" MEANS THE INSTITUTE FOR PUBLIC 16 LEADERSHIP AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS.

17 (B) (1) THERE IS AN INSTITUTE FOR PUBLIC LEADERSHIP IN THE 18 SCHOOL OF PUBLIC POLICY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK 19 CAMPUS.

20 (2) THE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC POLICY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF 21 MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS SHALL MANAGE THE INSTITUTE ACCORDING 22 TO THE POLICIES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE INSTITUTE IS TO:

2 (1) ENHANCE THE TEACHING OF PUBLIC LEADERSHIP THROUGH 3 ACADEMIC AND EXECUTIVE PROGRAMS THAT SUPPORT A DIVERSE RANGE OF 4 POPULATIONS, INCLUDING UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS, 5 MID-CAREER PROFESSIONALS, AND EXECUTIVE LEVEL OFFICIALS AND STAFF;

6 (2) PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH OPPORTUNITIES FOR EXPERIENTIAL 7 LEARNING WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL PARTNERS;

8 (3) SUPPORT STUDENTS, ESPECIALLY THOSE UNDERREPRESENTED 9 IN PUBLIC SERVICE POSITIONS, TO ACCESS PUBLIC LEADERSHIP CAREERS 10 THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS, SKILL DEVELOPMENT, AND PROFESSIONAL 11 MENTORSHIP;

12 (4) BUILD AN ACTIVE COMMUNITY OF ACCOMPLISHED LOCAL, STATE, 13 AND FEDERAL PRACTITIONERS ASSOCIATED WITH THE INSTITUTE TO SHARE THEIR 14 KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE WITH STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND THE PUBLIC; AND

15 (5) SERVE AS A RESOURCE FOR PUBLIC LEADERS IN THE STATE AND 16 THE NATION THROUGH RESEARCH ON ISSUES OF CURRENT AND EMERGING 17 SIGNIFICANCE.

18 (D) FOR EACH OF FISCAL YEARS 2023 THROUGH 2027, THE GOVERNOR 19 SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$1,500,000 20 TO THE INSTITUTE.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2022.

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
