- 4 (2) THE PROGRAM SHALL AID CHILDREN ENROLLED IN ACCORDANCE 5 WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY:
- 6 (I) REFERRING CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN NEED OF 7 INTENSIVE MENTAL OR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES TO APPROPRIATE CLINICS 8 OR PROGRAMS;
- 9 (II) TRAINING, COACHING, AND MENTORING TEACHERS AND 10 CAREGIVERS TO ADDRESS CHALLENGING BEHAVIORS;
- 11 (III) BUILDING PARTNERSHIPS WITH COMMUNITY RESOURCES; 12 AND
- 13 (IV) WORKING TO ENSURE CHILDREN HAVE STABLE, QUALITY 14 CHILD CARE PROGRAMS.
- 15 (E) IN IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAM, THE DIVISION MAY DESIGNATE 16 SPECIFIC REGIONS IN THE STATE AND CREATE UNIQUE APPROACHES IN EACH 17 DESIGNATED REGION.
- (F) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF
