- 15 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not more than
- 16 [\$124,500] **\$146,500** as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the relative volume
- of business and receipts in the clerk's office.
- 18 (b) A clerk shall devote his full working time to the duties of the clerk's office and
- 19 is entitled to the salary prescribed in subsection (a) of this section.

1 (c) The salary of a clerk is payable biweekly. 2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 3 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court while serving in a term of office beginning 4 5 before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or 6 compensation of the clerk of a circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the next 7 following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected 8 after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 10 October 1, 2022.
