Co. 05-22 FOR the purpose of establishing the Housing Opportunities Trust Fund as a nonreverting special fund to be used to promote equitable access to affordable housing for households of limited income in Howard County; requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development for Howard County to report on the activity of the Fund during the prior fiscal year on or before a certain date each year; and generally relating to funding for affordable housing in Howard County. BY adding to The Public Local Laws of Howard County Section 13.1600 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 16. Housing Opportunities Trust Fund Authorization" Article 14 – Public Local Laws of Maryland (1995 Edition and August 2008 Supplement, as amended) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article 14 – Howard County** SUBTITLE 16. HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES TRUST FUND AUTHORIZATION.
