BY adding to Article – Natural Resources Section 1–406 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) Preamble WHEREAS, The State of Maryland recognizes the unique cultural and ecological benefits of preserving old-growth forests; and WHEREAS, At present, many of the old-growth forests located on land preserved under the State's land conservation programs lack formal protection; now, therefore, SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16 17	3. A HIGH DEGREE OF STRUCTURAL DIVERSITY CHARACTERIZED BY MULTIPLE GROWTH LAYERS REFLECTING A BROAD SPECTRUM OF AGES IS PRESENT;

8 9 10	(B) WHENEVER THE DEPARTMENT OR THE MARYLAND ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST IDENTIFIES AN OLD-GROWTH FOREST ON STATE CONSERVATION LAND, THE LAND SHALL BE MANAGED IN A MANNER THAT: PROHIBITS LOGGING.
11	(1) MINIMIZES DISTURBANCE TO THE OLD GROWTH FOREST;
12	(2) PRIORITIZES PASSIVE RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES;
13 14	(3) PROHIBITS LOGGING OR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC AMENITIES WITHIN THE OLD GROWTH FOREST; AND
15 16	(4) Minimizes risks to the old-growth forest posed by disease and invasive species.
17 18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
