- 3 (B) If A PHYSICIAN OR AN ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE HAS DOCUMENTED
 4 PROOF THAT THE MINOR RECEIVED A TRANSCRANIAL DOPPLER ULTRASOUND
 5 RELATED TO SICKLE CELL DISEASE IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 12 MONTHS,
 6 THE PHYSICIAN OR ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE MAY DECLINE TO REFER THE
