- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 13 Article – Education

- 15 (a) The president of the county board is entitled to receive [\$10,000] **\$20,000**16 annually as compensation, the vice president is entitled to receive [\$9,000] **\$19,000**17 annually as compensation, and, except for the student member, the other board members
  18 are entitled to receive [\$8,000] **\$18,000** each annually as compensation.
- 19 (b) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall be 20 granted a scholarship of \$8,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education costs.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the president, vice president, members, and student member of the



- 1 Anne Arundel County Board of Education while serving in a term of office beginning before
- 2 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
- 3 compensation of the president, vice president, members, and student member of the Anne
- 4 Arundel County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following
- 5 term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the
- 6 effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  $8\,\,$  1, 2022.
