1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alzheimer’s Disease and Dementia – Council and Coordination of Services**
3 **(Dementia Services Act of 2022)**

4 FOR the purpose of renaming the Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related
5 Disorders Council to be the Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related
6 Dementias Council; establishing the terms of the appointed members of the ~~Virginia~~
7 ~~I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related Disorders~~ Council; altering the staffing and
8 reporting requirements of the Council; establishing the position of Director of
9 Dementia Services ~~Coordination~~ and Brain Health in the Maryland Department of
10 Health; repealing the termination date for the Council; and generally relating to the
11 Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related ~~Disorders~~ Dementias Council and
12 the Director of Dementia Services ~~Coordination~~ and Brain Health.

27 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

28 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

29 **Article – Health – General**

30 Subtitle 32. Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related [Disorders] **DEMENTIAS**
 31 Council.

33 (A) In this subtitle[,] **THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
 34 **INDICATED.**

35 (B) “Council” means the Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer’s Disease and Related
 36 ~~Disorders~~ **DEMENTIAS** Council.

1 (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF DEMENTIA SERVICES
2 ~~COORDINATION AND BRAIN HEALTH~~ ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBTITLE 32A OF THIS
3 TITLE.

4 13-3202.

5 There is a Virginia I. Jones Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders ~~Disorders~~ DEMENTIAS
6 Council.

7 13-3203.

8 (a) The Council consists of the following members:

9 (1) One member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of
10 the Senate;

11 (2) One member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the
12 House;

13 (3) The Secretary of Health, or the Secretary's designee;

14 (4) The Secretary of Aging, or the Secretary's designee;

15 (5) The Executive Director of the Alzheimer's Association, Greater
16 Maryland Chapter, or the Executive Director's designee;

17 (6) The President of the Alzheimer's Association, National Capital Area
18 Chapter, or the President's designee; and

19 (7) The following members, appointed by the Governor:

20 (i) Seven health care professionals with relevant professional
21 experience;

22 (ii) Three human service professionals with relevant professional
23 experience;

24 (iii) One elder law attorney with relevant professional experience;

25 (iv) Two research professionals with relevant professional
26 experience;

27 (v) Two family caregivers of individuals with Alzheimer's disease or
28 a related disorder; and

1 (vi) At the recommendation of the Council, any other member
2 necessary to fulfill the duties of the Council.

3 (b) To the extent practicable, the members appointed to the Council shall reflect
4 the geographic, racial, ethnic, cultural, and gender diversity of the State.

6 (a) The members of the Council shall select the chair of the Council.

7 (b) A member of the Council:

8 (1) May not receive compensation as a member of the Council; but

9 (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State
10 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

11 **(C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL IS 3**
12 **YEARS.**

13 **(2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ARE**
14 **STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR THE APPOINTED MEMBERS**
15 **OF THE COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 1, 2022.**

16 **(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, AN APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO**
17 **SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.**

18 **(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES**
19 **ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND**
20 **QUALIFIES.**

22 (a) The [Department] **DIRECTOR**, with assistance from the ~~DEPARTMENT OF~~
23 ~~LEGISLATIVE SERVICES AND THE~~ Department of Aging, shall provide staff support for
24 the Council.

25 (b) The [Department] **DIRECTOR** may request staffing assistance from public
26 health entities with an interest in the duties of the Council.

28 The Council shall:

29 (1) Update the State Plan on Alzheimer's Disease and Related ~~Disorders~~
30 **DEMENTIAS** and advocate for the State Plan;

1 (2) (i) Examine the needs of individuals with Alzheimer’s disease and
2 related ~~disorders~~ DEMENTIAS and their caregivers; and

3 (ii) Identify methods through which the State can most effectively
4 and efficiently assist in meeting those needs;

5 (3) Advise the Governor and the General Assembly on policy, funding,
6 regulatory, and other issues related to individuals with Alzheimer’s disease and related
7 ~~disorders~~ DEMENTIAS and their caregivers; and

8 (4) Develop and promote strategies to encourage brain health and reduce
9 cognitive decline.

11 On or before September 1 [each year], **2022, AND ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1**
12 **EVERY 5 YEARS THEREAFTER**, the Council shall [report to the Governor and, in
13 accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the
14 activities and recommendations of the Council] **ISSUE AND PUBLISH AN UPDATE TO THE**
15 **STATE PLAN ON ALZHEIMER’S DISEASE AND RELATED ~~DISORDERS~~ DEMENTIAS.**

1 THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR SHALL BE A FULL-TIME AND PERMANENT
2 POSITION.

4 (A) THE PURPOSE OF THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR IS TO COORDINATE AND
5 FACILITATE COMMUNICATION RELATING TO DEMENTIA SERVICES IN THE STATE.

6 (B) THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

7 (1) COORDINATE THE DEPARTMENT'S APPROACH TO ADDRESSING
8 ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND OTHER FORMS OF DEMENTIA AND BRAIN HEALTH,
9 INCLUDING THROUGH PUBLIC AWARENESS, PREVENTION, AND EARLY DETECTION
10 AND DIAGNOSIS;

11 (2) STAFF THE COUNCIL AND ~~IMPLEMENT~~ OVERSEE
12 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE PLAN ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED
13 DISORDERS DEMENTIAS;

14 (3) ASSESS, ANALYZE, AND CONDUCT OUTREACH TO SHARE
15 COGNITIVE HEALTH AND DEMENTIA-RELATED DATA;

16 (4) ~~IDENTIFY AND SHARE DEMENTIA-SPECIFIC TRAINING WITH~~
17 ~~STAKEHOLDERS WHO ENGAGE WITH INDIVIDUALS WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE OR~~
18 ~~OTHER FORMS OF DEMENTIA~~ DEVELOP AND MONITOR IMPLEMENTATION
19 MILESTONES AND MEASURABLE OUTCOMES TO ASSESS PROGRESS IN ACHIEVING

22 (5) IDENTIFY EFFICIENCIES ACROSS STATE AGENCIES THAT AID
23 INDIVIDUALS WITH DEMENTIA AND THEIR CAREGIVERS, AND COORDINATE PUBLIC
24 AND PRIVATE STAKEHOLDER PARTNERSHIPS;

25 (6) APPLY FOR GRANTS TO ENABLE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
26 STATE PLAN ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DEMENTIAS GOALS TO
27 REDUCE THE RISK OF DEMENTIA, AND IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF CARE FOR
28 INDIVIDUALS WITH DEMENTIA AND THEIR CAREGIVERS; AND

29 (7) CARRY OUT OTHER DUTIES RELEVANT TO THE SUPPORT OF
30 INDIVIDUALS WITH DEMENTIA AS MAY BE ASSIGNED BY THE ~~DIRECTOR OF THE~~
31 ~~CENTER FOR CHRONIC DISEASE PREVENTION AND CONTROL~~ DEPARTMENT.

1 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2023, AND ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1

- 1 (1) five members in 2024;
- 2 (2) five members in 2025;
- 3 (3) five members in 2026; and
- 4 (4) any other member appointed by the Governor under § 13–3203(a)(7)(vi)
- 5 of the Health – General Article in 2027.

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
