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Young Readers Programs – Establishment (Young Readers Program Expansion Act)

FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore City Young Readers Program within the
Division of Children and Youth of the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, Youth,
and Victim Services to mail free, high-quality books to certain children; establishing
the Young Readers Matching Grant Program within the Division to provide
matching grants to counties to support the establishment and operation of book
gifting services; requiring the Deputy Director of the Division to administer the
programs; and generally relating to Young Readers Programs.

 WHEREAS, The Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, Youth, and Victim Services
 has been funding the Baltimore City Young Readers Program since 2016; and
 WHEREAS, The Program has been budgeted at \$200,000 annually; and

- 22 WHEREAS, The Program has been undertaken in partnership with the 23 Banneker–Douglass Museum Foundation; and

2 (2) "AFFILIATED SERVICE" MEANS A BOOK–GIFTING SERVICE 3 AFFILIATED WITH DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY.

4 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE YOUNG READERS MATCHING GRANT 5 PROGRAM.

6 (B) THERE IS A YOUNG READERS MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM IN THE 7 DIVISION.

8 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO COUNTIES 9 THAT:

10(1)SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF AFFILIATED11SERVICES; AND

12(2)CONTRIBUTE AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING13PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION OF AN AFFILIATED SERVICE IN THE COUNTY.

14 (D) THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

15 (E) (1) A COUNTY MAY SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A PROGRAM GRANT 16 ON THE FORM THAT THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR REQUIRES.

17 (2) AN APPLICATION FOR A PROGRAM GRANT SHALL:

18(I)IDENTIFY AN AFFILIATED SERVICE OPERATING IN THE19COUNTY; AND

(II) INCLUDE A PLAN TO ENSURE THAT THE AFFILIATED
 SERVICE IS ABLE TO GIFT BOOKS TO ELIGIBLE CHILDREN, INCLUDING CHILDREN IN
 LOW-INCOME ZIP CODES WITHIN THE COUNTY.

23 (F) FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE 24 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 TO THE PROGRAM.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2022.
