- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "IMMIGRANT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL:
18 19	(1) WHOSE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN IS A COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES;
20	(2) WHO IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE UNITES STATES; AND
21	(3) WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
