3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Agriculture to develop, publish, and 4 regularly update a fact sheet on the care and protection of pets in the event of an 5 eviction or other loss of possession of real property; requiring the fact sheet to be 6 published in a certain manner and distributed to certain persons at certain times; 7 requiring a sheriff, constable, or other official, under certain circumstances, to return 8 a pet to a tenant or certain other person or to contact an animal shelter or a rescue 9 organization and provide certain notice; prohibiting the leaving of a pet on public property; and generally relating to actions for possession of real property and pet 10 11 protections.
