A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commission on African American History and Culture – Alterations**
3 **(Senator Verda Welcome Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Historical Trust to provide certain support to
5 capital projects that received funding from the African American Heritage
6 Preservation Program; establishing the Commission on African American History
7 and Culture as an independent agency; requiring the Governor to include certain
8 appropriations in the annual State budget bill; and generally relating to the
9 Commission on African American History and Culture.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That Section(s) 9.5–401 through 9.5–408, respectively, and the subtitle “Subtitle 4.
14 Commission on African American History and Culture” of Article – State Government of
15 the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 9–3501 through 9–3508,
16 respectively, and the subtitle “Subtitle 35. Commission on African American History and
17 Culture”.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
19 as follows:

20 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

21 5A–301.

22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (m) “Trust” means the Maryland Historical Trust.

24 5A–330.

25 (b) (1) There is an African American Heritage Preservation Program in the
26 Trust.

27 (2) The purpose of the Program is to identify and preserve buildings,
28 communities, and sites of historical and cultural importance to the African American
29 experience in the State.

30 (3) The Trust shall develop and administer the Program in partnership
31 with the Commission.

32 (4) **THE TRUST SHALL PROVIDE OPERATIONAL AND PROGRAM**
33 **SUPPORT FOR ALL CAPITAL PROJECTS THAT RECEIVED FUNDING FROM THE**
34 **PROGRAM.**

1 (c) (6) For each fiscal year, the Governor shall include in the annual operating
2 or capital budget an appropriation of ~~[\$1,000,000]~~ **\$5,000,000** to the AAHP Grant Fund.

5 (A) There is a Commission on African American History and Culture [in the
6 Governor’s Office of Community Initiatives].

7 (B) **THE COMMISSION IS AN INDEPENDENT UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE**
8 **BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.**

9 9–3506.

10 (c) Subject to the rules and policies adopted by the Commission [and the
11 administrative supervision of the Governor in accordance with Title 8, Subtitle 3 of this
12 article], the director shall:

13 (1) administer the activities of the Commission; and

14 (2) supervise the appointment and removal of Commission personnel.

16 (a) (1) The Commission may seek money from the federal government,
17 foundations, and private sources in addition to State financing.

18 (2) The Commission may accept gifts, grants, donations, bequests, or
19 endowments for any of its purposes.

20 (b) Money received under subsection (a) of this section, income from the operation
21 of the Banneker–Douglass Museum, and money from educational materials and activities
22 of the Commission are not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

23 (c) (1) **FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE**
24 **ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$1,600,000 FOR THE COMMISSION.**

25 (2) **FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE**
26 **ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$3,000,000 FOR CAPITAL REPAIRS AT**
27 **THE BANNEKER–DOUGLASS MUSEUM INCLUDING REPAIRS TO THE HEATING AND**
28 **COOLING SYSTEMS, ELEVATOR REPAIRS, TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES, RESTORATION**
29 **OF THE ORIGINAL FLOORING, AND THE UPDATE OF PERMANENT EXHIBITS TO**
30 **INCLUDE ADDITIONAL MARYLAND BLACK HISTORY MILESTONES.**

1 **(D)** Money maintained under this section is subject to audit by the State, including
2 the Legislative Auditor.

4 **(b)** The Governor’s Office of Community Initiatives shall include the following
5 units:

6 (1) the Governor’s Office on Service and Volunteerism, under Subtitle 2 of
7 this title;

8 (2) the Commission on Indian Affairs, under Subtitle 3 of this title;

9 (3) [the Commission on African American History and Culture, under
10 Subtitle 4 of this title;

11 (4)] the Commission on LGBTQ Affairs, under Subtitle 5 of this title; and

12 **[(5)] (4)** any other unit as authorized by law or executive order.

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
14 1, 2022.
