AHC Inc. is a non-profit, affordable housing developer that helps communities thrive in the Maryland, Northern Virginia, and Washington, DC region. We provide a wide array of educational programs and social services in our community centers to help residents build more stable and successful lives. AHC is among the largest developers of affordable and mixed-income housing in the Washington-Baltimore metro region. Since 1975, we have worked hard to meet the ongoing need for affordable housing in our highly competitive and very expensive market. Today, the organization has developed or preserved 50+ properties providing more than 7,500 affordable, workforce and market-rate apartments. Our commitment to the communities we serve is deep and ongoing. We take pride in developing quality properties that strengthen neighborhoods.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

AHCs mission is the creation of affordable housing coupled with supportive services to ensure the success of our residents. Key among the needs of lower-income households is the need for affordable childcare. The new community of nearly 200 affordable homes to be constructed in District 18 near the intersection of Viers Mill and Randolph roads incorporates 3,000 square feet of space that is designated for use as a childcare facility that will serve approximately 40-50 children. The capital budget incorporates funds to construct the core and shell of the childcare space. This request seeks a state appropriation to fund the build-out the interior of the space to meet the needs of the child care provider that AHC selects to operate the center and comply with applicable building code requirements.

4010 Randolph Road is a joint development partnership between AHC Inc. and Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland that will create approximately 200 new affordable homes in Montgomery County. Construction of this new community is expected to begin in July 2022 and conclude late July 2024.

The capital budget for AHC's 168 rental units includes funds to construct the core and shell of a 3,000 square foot childcare center within one of our multifamily rental buildings. AHC has a successful track record of partnering with childcare providers for on-site care opportunities for our residents and members of the surrounding community. AHC is actively interviewing Montgomery County childcare providers to choose a partner for Randolph Road. This legislative bond initiative request seeks funds to build-out the interior of the childcare center, with the intention that the center would be completed at the same time that the apartments lease-up.

AHC can provide additional information as requested about the impact on the number of employees and operating budget (question #24) of the childcare center once we've chosen a partner.
