"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That this Act may not alter the term of a member of the Wildlife Advisory Commission that is serving as of the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall appoint one member to the Wildlife Advisory Commission in accordance with § 1–102(c)(2)(i) of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act. The member shall serve for a term of 4 years which shall begin on July 1, 2024, and shall terminate at the end of June 30, 2028, and the member shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.";
