17 18	WHEREAS, Maryland has had a long history and tradition of distilling various forms of whiskey since before the American Revolution; and
19 20	WHEREAS, Maryland Rye Whiskey is a distinct and notable spirit unique from other distilled whiskey; and
21 22	WHEREAS, Maryland Rye Whiskey demanded national respect as one of the best whiskeys in the United States in the 19th and early 20th centuries; and

- WHEREAS, Rye is a plentiful, locally grown cover crop affording an opportunity to highlight local agriculture and support local spirits production; and
- WHEREAS, The Maryland distillery industry, once a robust and significant producer of spirits, is again growing and contributing to the economy and prominence of the State; now, therefore,
- 6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 7 That Section(s) 7–318 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland 8 be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–319.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 10 as follows:

13 MARYLAND RYE OR MARYLAND RYE WHISKEY IS THE STATE SPIRIT.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
