- 1 (C) THE PROGRAM SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED AND ADMINISTERED BY THE 2 INTERAGENCY COMMISSION.
- 3 (D) (1) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION SHALL:
- 4 (I) PROVIDE GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS FOR STADIUM 5 IMPROVEMENTS;
- 6 (II) DEVELOP A PROCEDURE FOR A COUNTY BOARD TO APPLY FOR A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM; AND
- 8 (III) DEVELOP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR A COUNTY 9 BOARD TO RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM.
- 10 (2) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION MAY NOT:
- 11 (I) AWARD GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS FOR ROUTINE 12 MAINTENANCE ON PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STADIUMS UNDER THE PROGRAM; OR
- 13 (II) REQUIRE A PROJECT TO COMPLY WITH THE STATE AND LOCAL COST-SHARE ESTABLISHED FOR EACH COUNTY IN REGULATIONS.
- 15 (E) (1) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025, THE GOVERNOR SHALL 16 INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL OPERATING OR CAPITAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION 17 OF \$50,000,000 FOR THE PROGRAM.

- 22 **(F)** THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS 23 NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2023.
