12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a Position Identification 13 Number (PIN) shall be created in the Department of Agriculture for the State Ombudsman 14 for Value–Added Agriculture.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, during the first year after 16 the initial appointment of the State Ombudsman for Value–Added Agriculture, the priority 17 function of the Ombudsman is to focus on implementing the recommendations of the Task 18 Force to Study the Feasibility of Return to State Meat Process Inspection.

19 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2023.
