2 **Transit – Commuter Bus Service – Procurement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transit Administration, in selecting a
4 commuter bus service provider, to use the competitive sealed proposal method of
5 procurement and to conduct the procurement in accordance with certain provisions
6 of State law; and generally relating to procurement for commuter bus service.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 **7–504.1.**

16 **IN SELECTING A COMMUTER BUS SERVICE PROVIDER, THE ADMINISTRATION**
17 **SHALL:**

1 **(1) USE THE COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSAL METHOD OF**
2 **PROCUREMENT; AND**

3 **(2) CONDUCT THE PROCUREMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE**
4 **PROVISIONS OF AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER DIVISION II OF THE**
5 **STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to
7 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or
8 application to any contracts to provide commuter bus service granted before the effective
9 date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
11 1, 2023.
