- 4 (E) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.
- 5 (F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS **\$205 \$1,000**.

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2023.
