Pesticide Registration - PFAS Testing - Requirements

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting, beginning on a certain date, the Secretary of Agriculture from registering a pesticide for use against mosquitoes in the State unless the distributor of the pesticide submits to the Department of Agriculture certain test results and a certain affidavit; prohibiting, beginning on a certain date, the Secretary from registering a pesticide for use in the State unless the distributor of the pesticide submits to the Department certain test results and a certain affidavit; and generally relating to the registration of pesticides in the State.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 24 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.



- 1 (g) "Distributor" means a person who imports, manufactures, produces, mixes, or consigns pesticides as part of a commercial enterprise.

- 4 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 5 INDICATED.
- 6 (2) "PASSED THE PFAS TEST" MEANS PFAS TEST RESULTS
 7 INDICATING THAT THE SUM OF THE CONCENTRATIONS OF ANALYTES IN A PESTICIDE
- 8 TOTAL:
- 9 (I) Less than 100 parts per trillion based on 10 conventional testing performed with:
- 1. LIQUID CHROMATOGRAPHY-MASS SPECTROMETRY;
- 12 2. U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY
- 13 **METHOD 1633; OR**
- 3. ANY OTHER MASS SPECTROMETRIC METHOD THAT IS
- 15 ACCEPTED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND SHOWN TO BE
- 16 A VALID METHOD; OR
- 17 (II) LESS THAN 10 PARTS PER BILLION IN TOTAL ORGANIC
- 18 FLUORINE AS DETERMINED BY A VALIDATED TOTAL ORGANIC FLUORINE ANALYSIS.
- 19 (3) "PFAS" MEANS PERFLUOROALKYL AND POLYFLUOROALKYL
- 20 SUBSTANCES.
- 21 (4) "PFAS TEST" OR "PFAS TESTING" MEANS A TEST:
- 22 (I) TO DETERMINE THE CONCENTRATION OF ANALYTES IN A
- 23 PESTICIDE; AND
- 24 (II) THAT IS PERFORMED BY A LABORATORY:
- 25 1. IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE
- 26 ENVIRONMENT AS CAPABLE OF TESTING FOR PFAS; OR
- 27 2. USED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
- 28 AGENCY FOR PFAS TESTING.

- 1 (B) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2024, THE SECRETARY MAY NOT REGISTER A
 2 PESTICIDE FOR USE AGAINST MOSQUITOES IN THE STATE UNLESS THE
 3 DISTRIBUTOR OF THE PESTICIDE SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT WITH EACH
 4 REGISTRATION APPLICATION:
- 5 (1) PFAS TEST RESULTS INDICATING THAT THE PESTICIDE HAS 6 PASSED THE PFAS TEST; AND
- 7 (2) A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING TO THE LEGITIMACY OF THE 8 PFAS TEST RESULTS.
- 9 (C) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2026, THE SECRETARY MAY NOT REGISTER A
 10 PESTICIDE FOR USE IN THE STATE UNLESS THE DISTRIBUTOR OF THE PESTICIDE
 11 SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT WITH EACH REGISTRATION APPLICATION:
- 12 (1) PFAS TEST RESULTS INDICATING THAT THE PESTICIDE HAS 13 PASSED THE PFAS TEST; AND
- 14 (2) A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING TO THE LEGITIMACY OF THE 15 PFAS TEST RESULTS.
- 16 (D) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE THE 17 DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT PFAS TESTING ON PESTICIDES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2023.
