BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Health Occupations Section 8-101(a) and (b)Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement) BY adding to Article – Health Occupations Section 8–514 Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Health Occupations

26 (b) "Authorized prescriber" means any licensed dentist, licensed dental hygienist with prescriptive authority under § 4–206.4 of this article, licensed physician, licensed podiatrist, licensed veterinarian, advanced practice **REGISTERED** nurse with prescriptive authority under § 8–508 OR § 8–514 TITLE 8 of this article, licensed nurse anesthetist, or other individual authorized by law to prescribe prescription or nonprescription drugs or devices.
