10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)							

Founded in 1929, the Natural History Society of Maryland (NHSM) preserves Maryland's natural history, promotes scientific research, and educates Maryland citizens in the natural sciences and STEM. This project's goal is to create a much-improved facility, capable of serving the scientific community and thousands of visitors a year while also revitalizing the local economy. In 2007, NHSM purchased a vacant building in Overlea, Baltimore County. This 9,000 sf headquarters now houses over 75,000 artifacts and specimens of fossils, minerals, plants, insects, reptiles, birds and mammals collected from the 1880s to present. In addition, it has two rooms for classroom instruction, lectures, programs and displays. Today, NHSM serves the scientific community and offers a robust natural history program onsite, online, and in the field for all Marylanders.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Phase One Renovation is the redesign, renovation, and upgrade of the NHSM's current facility. Included is the conversion of the 4,000 sf upper level into flexible galleries which will display collection highlights and provide much needed teaching/learning space for students and families. The 4,000 sf lower level will be renovated to provide advanced collections storage and workspace for scientists and curators. A small, new mechanical space for upgraded HVAC systems will also be added. Finally, the entire exterior of the building will be replaced and wrapped in bold new environmental graphics. A prominent, free-standing graphic pylon will identify the site as that of the NHSM. This bright new identity will compliment other community development initiatives along the Belair Road corridor and will spark much-needed business growth. The new spaces will allow the NHSM to serve many more Maryland students and families.

Note on Private donations: not included in the Proposed Funding Sources above is an endowment goal of \$1,000,000 which will be raised from private sources (to date \$600,000 has been received in a bequest.)

Note on Projected Operating Budget: The Phase One Renovation will allow the NHSM to hire more staff who will serve many more visitors and program participants. This will produce more revenues from fees, grants, and other earned sources. However, affordable and free access will always be available to those who need them.

Note on Number of People Served: The current and future numbers are for people served at or from the facility. Future numbers will at least triple given the improved facilities and expanded staffing. Online and social media programs are not included and are very significant. For example, NHSM's YouTube page has 5,000 views per month now which will grow in the future
