Potomac Fire Company Number 2, Incorporated is a community-based fire company located in Westernport, MD. The organization aims to provide high-quality fire protection services to Westernport and surrounding communities. Westernport is currently 0.91 square miles with a population of 1,888 residents. The additional first-due response area includes the communities of McCoole, MD, and Luke, MD, since the closure of the Verso Luke Paper Mill. Potomac Fire Company has over 300 calls for service annually.						

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Potomac Fire Co. Inc. seeks funding for much-needed station enhancements, including upgrades and repairs. Our building is in dire need of several repairs, including an apparatus bay floor refinish. Currently, our foundation is not built and suited to handle the weight of our apparatus, which exceeds 250,000 pounds. A new floor would improve firefighter life safety and enhance our operational capabilities. Additionally, we seek funding for new gear racks for enhanced storage of fire personal protective equipment (PPE) that would allow for safer and cleaner PPE storage and decrease the risk of contracted occupational cancer. It should be noted that the front apron of the firehouse has significant cracking that needs to be repaired promptly to prevent injuries from entering the firehouse.
