On page 1, in line 7, after "forms;" insert "<u>requiring certain physicians who</u> <u>perform abortions or certain hospitals, facilities, and institutions in which an abortion</u> <u>is performed to report the abortion to the Department;</u>"; in line 12, after "Care;" insert "<u>authorizing the State Board of Physicians to take certain disciplinary actions against</u> <u>a licensee who violates the abortion reporting requirement;</u>"; in line 21, after "19–3B–03.1;" insert "<u>20–217 to be under the new part "Part V. Reporting Requirements";</u>"; and after line 25, insert:

"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u>

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PART V. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

<u>20–217.</u>

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ABORTION" MEANS THE USE OR PRESCRIPTION OF ANY INSTRUMENT, MEDICINE, DRUG, OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE OR DEVICE TO INTENTIONALLY KILL THE FETUS OF A WOMAN KNOWN TO BE PREGNANT OR TO INTENTIONALLY TERMINATE THE PREGNANCY OF A WOMAN KNOWN TO BE PREGNANT.

(2) <u>"ABORTION" DOES NOT INCLUDE ACTIONS PERFORMED AFTER</u> <u>VIABILITY TO PRODUCE LIVE BIRTH AND PRESERVE THE LIFE AND HEALTH OF</u> <u>THE FETUS BORN ALIVE, OR TO REMOVE A DEAD UNBORN FETUS.</u>

(B) <u>A PHYSICIAN PERFORMING AN ABORTION OR A HOSPITAL, A</u> FACILITY, OR AN INSTITUTION IN WHICH AN ABORTION IS PERFORMED SHALL REPORT THE ABORTION TO THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) (1) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL:

(I) **BE MADE ON A FORM DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT;**

(II) <u>BE COMPLETED BY THE PHYSICIAN PERFORMING THE</u> <u>ABORTION OR BY THE HOSPITAL, FACILITY, OR INSTITUTION IN WHICH THE</u> <u>ABORTION WAS PERFORMED;</u>

(III) <u>BE TRANSMITTED ANNUALLY TO THE VITAL STATISTICS</u>

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ADMINISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER EACH REPORTING YEAR; AND

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(IV) INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- <u>1.</u> <u>The county and state of residence of the</u> <u>PATIENT;</u>
 - 2. THE AGE, RACE, AND MARITAL STATUS OF THE

PATIENT;

3. <u>THE ESTIMATED GESTATIONAL AGE OF THE FETUS</u> <u>AT THE TIME OF THE ABORTION;</u>

4. <u>The month during which the abortion was</u>

PERFORMED; AND

5. <u>The method of abortion used by the</u> <u>Physician to terminate the pregnancy.</u>

(2) <u>The report required under subsection (b) of this</u> <u>Section May include the primary reason provided by the patient for</u> <u>The abortion, including:</u>

- <u>(I)</u> <u>RAPE;</u>
- (II) INCEST;
- (III) FINANCIAL HARDSHIP;

(Over)

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- (IV) EDUCATIONAL CONCERNS;
- (V) LACK OF RESOURCES;
- (VI) PHYSICAL OR MENTAL INFIRMITY;
- (VII) SERIOUS FETAL DEFORMITY;
- (VIII) PRESSURE FROM OTHER INDIVIDUALS;
- (IX) <u>ILL-TIMED PREGNANCY; AND</u>
- (X) ABANDONMENT BY PARTNER OR FAMILY.

(D) <u>The report required under subsection (b) of this section</u> MAY NOT:

(1) INCLUDE THE NAME OR STREET ADDRESS OF THE PATIENT; OR

(2) INCLUDE ANY IDENTIFIERS THAT COULD BE USED TO IDENTIFY A PATIENT OR THE PHYSICIAN WHO PERFORMED THE ABORTION.

(E) (1) <u>A PHYSICIAN WHO PERFORMS AN ABORTION AND FAILS TO</u> <u>SUBMIT THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS</u> <u>GUILTY OF UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO</u> <u>DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 14–404 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS</u> <u>ARTICLE.</u> HB1051/333921/01 Wivell Amendments to HB 1051 Page 5 of 5

(2) <u>A PHYSICIAN OR AN INDIVIDUAL ACTING ON BEHALF OF A</u> <u>HOSPITAL, A FACILITY, OR AN INSTITUTION WHO DOES NOT SUBMIT THE REPORT</u> <u>REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO AN</u> <u>ADMINISTRATIVE FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.</u>

(F) <u>THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS</u> <u>SECTION.</u>".

On page 6, after line 20, insert:

"<u>Article – Health Occupations</u>

14-404.

(a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14–405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:

(45) Fails to comply with § 1–223 of this article; [or]

(46) <u>Fails to comply with the requirements of the Prescription Drug</u> <u>Monitoring Program under Title 21, Subtitle 2A of the Health – General Article; OR</u>

(47) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH § 20–217 OF THE HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE.".
