# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 813

(First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Henson" and substitute ", Henson, Conaway, Taylor, Kaufman, Phillips, and Williams".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 24, inclusive.

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with "(1)" in line 8 down through "(C)" in line 19; in line 19, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "(D)"; in line 20, strike the bracket; and in line 22, strike the brackets.

On page 3, in line 2, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike "(D)".

On page 4, in line 1, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "30"; in line 13, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "(E)"; in line 18, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "(D)(1)(I)"; in line 27, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "(F)"; in line 28, strike ", THE COMPTROLLER,"; and after line 29, insert:

"(F) (1) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN OBLIGOR WHOSE INDIVIDUAL INCOME FOR THE CURRENT YEAR IS NOT GREATER THAN 250% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES UNLESS THE OBLIGOR WAS JUDICIALLY DETERMINED AT THE TIME THE MOST RECENT CHILD SUPPORT ORDER WAS ENTERED TO BE VOLUNTARILY IMPOVERISHED UNDER § 12–204 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (2) TO DETERMINE THE INCOME OF AN OBLIGOR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CONSIDER:
- (I) THE INCOME OF THE OBLIGOR AT THE TIME THE MOST RECENT CHILD SUPPORT ORDER WAS ENTERED; OR
- (II) INFORMATION ON THE OBLIGOR'S INCOME PROVIDED BY THE OBLIGOR, THE COMPTROLLER, OR AN EMPLOYER OF THE OBLIGOR.".

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 30 on page 4 through line 23 on page 5, inclusive.

On page 5, strike beginning with "It" in line 25 down through "effect." in line 27.
