<u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1396</u> (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Tomlinson" and substitute "Tomlinson, Pena-Melnyk, Cullison, Alston, Bagnall, Chisholm, Guzzone, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kerr, Kipke, R. Lewis, Lopez, Martinez, M. Morgan, Reilly, Rosenberg, Szeliga, Taveras, White Holland, and Woods"; strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute "Maryland Department of Health – Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Recovery Levels of Care – Study"; strike beginning with "establish" in line 4 down through "programs" in line 7 and substitute "conduct a certain study on linkages between levels of care within the substance use disorder treatment and recovery continuum of care"; strike beginning with "the" in line 7 down through "State" in line 9 and substitute "a study on linkages between levels of care within the substance use disorder treatment and recovery continuum of care"; and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 14, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 16, strike "the Laws of Maryland read as follows"; and after line 16, insert:

"(a) <u>The Maryland Department of Health shall conduct a study regarding the</u> <u>linkages between the various levels of care within the substance use disorder treatment</u> <u>and recovery continuum of care.</u>

(b) The study required under subsection (a) of this section shall examine:

(1) <u>linkages from high-intensity outpatient treatment programs to a</u> patient's need for comprehensive services, including:

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- (i) additional treatment;
- (ii) housing; and
- (iii) other social services support; and

(2) <u>existing requirements related to discharge planning in accreditation</u> <u>standards, statute, and regulation.</u>

(c) <u>The Department shall make recommendations on improvements to</u> <u>existing discharge and linkage requirements and improvements to the process for</u> <u>enforcing the discharge and linkage requirements.</u>

(d) On or before December 1, 2024, the Department shall report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the study conducted under subsection (a) of this section.".

On pages 1 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 6 on page 5, inclusive.

On page 5, in line 7, strike "3." and substitute "2.".
