AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Woods**” and substitute “**Woods, Pena–Melnyk, Cullison, Bhandari, Chisholm, Guzzone, Hill, Hutchinson, Kaiser, Kipke, Lopez, Reilly, Rosenberg, Szeliga, and White Holland**”; in line 4, after “court,” insert “on a certain motion and”; and in line 5, after “time;” insert “requiring a court to include the date the petition expires on the petition;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 8, after “**(2)**” insert “**(I)**”; in the same line, strike “**THE**” and substitute “**SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, ON A MOTION, THE**”; in the same line, after “**SHOWN**” insert “**BASED ON THE PRESENTING BEHAVIOR OF THE INDIVIDUAL**”; in line 9, strike “**AN ADDITIONAL**” and substitute “**UP TO**”; in the same line, after “**DAYS**” insert “**AT A TIME, BUT NOT TO EXCEED A TOTAL OF 30 DAYS**”; and after line 9, insert:

“(II) 1. A MOTION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH MUST BE MADE BY THE ORIGINAL PETITIONER.

2. EACH EXTENSION SHALL BE BASED ON A SEPARATE MOTION.

(3) A PETITION ENDORSED OR EXTENDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE SERVED EXPEDITIOUSLY.

(E) THE COURT SHALL INCLUDE ON THE PETITION THE DATE THE PETITION EXPIRES.”;
