AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "**Delegate Edelson**" and substitute "**Delegates Edelson**, **Allen**, **Addison**, **Boyce**, **Guyton**, **Healey**, **Lehman**, **T**. **Morgan**, **Ruth**, **and Terrasa**"; in line 5, after "service;" insert "requiring the Maryland Department of Transportation to incorporate the findings and recommendations of the study conducted under this Act into a certain transportation plan;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 12, after "(6)" insert "in consultation with the Maryland Commission on Disabilities and the State Coordinating Committee for Human Services Transportation,"; in line 13, strike "and"; and in line 17, after "riders" insert ";

- (8) <u>develop recommendations for service improvements to individuals</u> in areas outside of three–quarters of a mile of a fixed transportation route; and
- (9) <u>develop recommendations to address interjurisdictional restrictions</u> to paratransit services, including restrictions relating to medical appointments that cross jurisdictional lines".

On page 4, in line 6, strike the last "and"; after line 6, insert:

"(5) the Maryland Department of Transportation; and";

in line 7, strike "(5)" and substitute "(6)"; after line 7, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Department of Transportation shall incorporate the findings and recommendations of

the study conducted under Section 1 of this Act into the 2050 Maryland Transportation Plan.";

in line 8, strike "2." and substitute "<u>3.</u>"; in line 9, strike "1 year and 6 months" and substitute "<u>2 years</u>"; and in line 10, strike "December 31, 2025" and substitute "<u>June 30, 2026</u>".
