BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments. Article – State Government Section 9–2401(a), (b), (c), (g), (h), (k), (m), (o), and (r) Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) BY adding to Article – State Government Section 9-2438 through 9-2443 to be under the new part "Part IV. Deafblind Co-Navigation Services Program" Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1.
