FOR the purpose of authorizing certain persons to alter certain submerged aquatic
vegetation in a certain manner and in accordance with certain requirements;
authorizing a public utility company or telecommunications carrier to alter certain
submerged aquatic vegetation in a certain manner and in accordance with certain
requirements; altering certain requirements related to the alteration or removal of
certain submerged aquatic vegetation; and generally relating to submerged aquatic
vegetation in the tidal waters of the State.
