BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation

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
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- 1 (v) Has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits a 2 "major life activity" as defined in the federal Americans with Disabilities Act;

 3 (VI) PRESENTS DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT THE
- 4 APPLICANT WAS RELEASED FROM A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WITHIN THE PRIOR **60** 5 DAYS;
- 6 (VII) PRESENTS DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT THE 7 APPLICANT IS A YOUTH UNDER THE CARE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE 8 SERVICES;

- 15 (X) PRESENTS DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT THE 16 APPLICANT IS CURRENTLY UNDER THE CARE OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF 17 HEALTH; OR
- 18 (XI) PRESENTS OTHER DOCUMENTATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

- 21 (e) (1) This subsection only applies to an individual who holds a license and 22 who seeks a different class license to drive a motor vehicle that, under the individual's current license, the individual is not authorized to drive.
- 24 (2) The holder of a learner's instructional permit may not take the driver's license examination sooner than 14 days after the permit is issued.
- 26 (3) The 14 days' requirement may be waived if a subsequent learner's instructional permit is issued or applied for.
- 28 (4) A learner's instructional permit issued to an individual described in paragraph (1) of this subsection expires [180 days] 1 YEAR after THE date of issuance.
- 30 (5) A commercial driver's instructional permit issued to an individual described in paragraph (1) of this subsection expires 1 year after the date of issuance.

- 2 (d) (1) A license [held by a member of the armed forces of the United States
- 3 who is absent from this State on active service in the armed forces of the United States, or
- 4 a dependent of the member who is residing with the member outside the State, shall remain
- 5 in full force and effect during such absence | SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT
- 6 DURING AN ABSENCE FROM THE STATE IF THE LICENSE IS HELD BY:
- 7 (I) 1. A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
- 8 STATES WHO IS ABSENT FROM THIS STATE ON ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE ARMED
- 9 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES; OR
- 10 2. A DEPENDENT OF THE MEMBER WHO IS RESIDING
- 11 WITH THE MEMBER OUTSIDE THE STATE; OR
- 12 (II) 1. A CONTRACT EMPLOYEE WORKING ON BEHALF OF A
- 13 FEDERAL AGENCY OR BRANCH OF THE ARMED SERVICES WHO IS ABSENT FROM THE
- 14 STATE IN SERVICE OF THE CONTRACT; OR
- 2. A DEPENDENT OF THE CONTRACT EMPLOYEE WHO IS
- 16 RESIDING WITH THE CONTRACT EMPLOYEE OUTSIDE THE STATE.
- 17 (2) The license also shall remain in effect, if it would otherwise have
- 18 expired under this section, for a period of 30 days following the date of the licensee's return
- 19 to this State, or the member's discharge or separation from active service:
- 20 (i) If the licensee has in the licensee's immediate possession,
- 21 together with the licensee's driver's license, papers indicating the member's active service
- 22 outside this State or the member's discharge or separation; and
- 23 (ii) If the license is not otherwise suspended, revoked, or canceled
- 24 under this title during the 30-day period.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2024.
