BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 21-10A-04. Unless otherwise set by local law, a person who undertakes the towing or removal of a vehicle from a parking lot:
