- 18 standards established by the federal Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 (Title
- 19 XII of Public Law 99–570), and has satisfied all other requirements of that act as well as
- 20 any other requirements of this title.

 - (4) THE KNOWLEDGE TEST FOR DRIVING A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE OFFERED IN ENGLISH AND SPANISH.
