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1 (d) For the purposes of this section, an individual is qualified to vote the **(4)** 2 provisional ballot cast if the local board determines that: 3 (i) the individual is registered in the State; if the provisional ballot was cast because the voter failed to 4 (ii) provide required identification, the individual who cast the provisional ballot has met the 5 identification requirements established by the State Board; [and] 6 7 if the provisional ballot was cast during a period covered by a 8 court order or other order extending the time for closing the polls, the order has not been 9 invalidated by a subsequent court order; AND 10 (IV) IF THE PROVISIONAL BALLOT WAS CAST DURING EARLY 11 VOTING BEFORE A PRIMARY ELECTION BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS NOT 12 AFFILIATED WITH A POLITICAL PARTY, THE INDIVIDUAL APPLIED TO AFFILIATE 13 WITH A POLITICAL PARTY. 14 SECTION 2.
