- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Each county board shall provide each student in grades six through twelve with the telephone number of the [Maryland Youth Crisis Hotline] **988 SUICIDE AND CRISIS** LIFELINE by:

1(2)Printing the telephone number on a student's school identification card,2if provided.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a county board is not required 4 to reprint or reissue school handbooks or student school identification cards in use on the 5 effective date of this Act in order to comply with this Act.

6 SECTION 3. AND IT BE FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2024.
