- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Estates and Trusts

16 13–306.

17 (a) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a personal representative or trustee 18 may make an irrevocable transfer to another adult or trust company as custodian for the 19 benefit of a minor pursuant to § 13–309 of this subtitle, in the absence of a will or under a 20 will or trust that does not contain an authorization to do so.

(b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a conservator may make an irrevocable
transfer to another adult or trust company as custodian for the benefit of the minor
pursuant to § 13–309 of this subtitle.

24 (c) A transfer under subsection (a) or (b) of this section may be made only if:

#### HOUSE BILL 324

1 (1) The personal representative, trustee, or conservator considers the 2 transfer to be in the best interest of the minor;

3 (2) The transfer is not prohibited by or inconsistent with provisions of the 4 applicable will, trust agreement, or other governing instrument; and

5 (3) The transfer is authorized by the court if it exceeds [\$10,000] \$50,000
6 in value.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2024.
