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School Bus Stops – Monitoring Cameras and Safety Measures

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a law enforcement agency, under certain circumstances, to 4 issue a warning rather than a citation for a failure to stop for a school vehicle that is $\mathbf{5}$ recorded by a school bus monitoring camera; requiring the State Highway 6 Administration to develop a certain plan for improved safety measures at certain 7 school bus stops in Montgomery County and to report its findings to the Montgomery 8 County Council, the Montgomery County Department of Transportation, 9 Montgomery County Public Schools, the Montgomery County Vision Zero 10 Coordinator, and the Montgomery County Delegation to the General Assembly on or 11 before a certain date; and generally relating to school bus stops.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

2 (a) The State Highway Administration, in consultation with law enforcement 3 agencies, shall identify school bus stops located on State highways in Montgomery County 4 that experience high incidence of violations of § 21–706 of the Transportation Article and 5 develop a plan, including a timeline, for the implementation of additional safety measures 6 for those school bus stops.

7 (b) A plan developed under subsection (a) of this section shall include 8 consideration of the feasibility of constructing medians on undivided State highways at 9 locations with high incidence of violations.

10 (c) On or before December 31, 2024, the State Highway Administration shall 11 submit its plan to the Montgomery County Council, the Montgomery County Department 12 of Transportation, Montgomery County Public Schools, the Montgomery County Vision 13 Zero Coordinator, and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the 14 Montgomery County Delegation to the General Assembly.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
1, 2024.
