1 AN ACT concerning

State Emergency Medical Services Board – Licenses and Certificates – Application Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Board from $\mathbf{5}$ requiring an applicant to provide proof that the applicant is lawfully present in the 6 United States or have a Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer 7 Identification Number as a condition for licensure or certification; requiring the EMS 8 Board to require each applicant for a license to disclose the Social Security number 9 or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number of the applicant or, as permitted 10 under federal law, provide alternative documentation, and record the number or 11 alternative documentation in the application file to be provided upon request to the 12 Child Support Administration of the Department of Human Services for purposes of 13collecting child support from an obligor in arrears; and generally relating to application requirements for licensure and certification by the EMS Board. 14
