A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 State and Local Parks – Play Area Accessibility – Communication Boards

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources and local governing bodies to construct communication boards in certain newly constructed public play areas; authorizing the Department and local governing bodies to construct communication boards when making alterations to certain existing public play areas; providing for the funding of communication board construction; and generally relating to play area communication boards.

(g) "Local governing body" means the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission and the governing body of any county or Baltimore City.

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SUBTITLE 21. PLAY AREA ACCESSIBILITY.

5 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 6 INDICATED.

7 (B) (1) "ALTERATION" MEANS A CHANGE TO AN EXISTING PLAY AREA 8 THAT AFFECTS THE USABILITY OF THE PLAY AREA.

9 (2) "ALTERATION" DOES NOT INCLUDE NORMAL MAINTENANCE TO 10 AN EXISTING PLAY AREA THAT DOES NOT AFFECT THE USABILITY OF THE PLAY AREA.

11 (C) "COMMUNICATION BOARD" MEANS A DEVICE THAT DISPLAYS PHOTOS, 12 SYMBOLS, OR ILLUSTRATIONS TO ENABLE INDIVIDUALS WITH LIMITED LANGUAGE 13 SKILLS TO EXPRESS THEMSELVES AND COMMUNICATE.

14 (D) "LOCAL GOVERNING BODY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5–901 OF 15 THIS TITLE.

16 (E) "PLAY AREA" MEANS A PORTION OF A SITE CONTAINING PLAY 17 COMPONENTS DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTED FOR CHILDREN.

18 **(F) "SITE" MEANS:**

19(1) A PARCEL OF LAND WITH BOUNDARIES MARKED BY A PROPERTY20LINE; OR

21 (2) A DESIGNATED PORTION OF A PUBLIC RIGHT–OF–WAY.

22 **5–2102.**

(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO PLAY AREAS LOCATED WITHIN A
 PUBLIC PARK OR RECREATION AREA UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE
 DEPARTMENT OR A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT AND EACH LOCAL GOVERNING BODY RESPONSIBLE
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PLAY AREAS SHALL CONSTRUCT A COMMUNICATION
BOARD IN EACH NEWLY CONSTRUCTED PLAY AREA UNDER ITS JURISDICTION.

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1 (C) THE DEPARTMENT AND EACH LOCAL GOVERNING BODY RESPONSIBLE 2 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PLAY AREAS MAY CONSTRUCT A COMMUNICATION 3 BOARD IN AN EXISTING PLAY AREA UNDER ITS JURISDICTION WHEN MAKING 4 ALTERATIONS TO THAT PLAY AREA.

5 **5–2103.**

6 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE PROGRAM OPEN SPACE FUNDING 7 PROVIDED UNDER § 5–904 OF THIS TITLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 8 COMMUNICATION BOARDS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IN PLAY AREAS UNDER 9 ITS JURISDICTION.

10 (B) (1) A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY SHALL APPLY FOR PROGRAM OPEN 11 SPACE FUNDING UNDER § 5–905 OF THIS TITLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 12 COMMUNICATION BOARDS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IN PLAY AREAS UNDER 13 ITS JURISDICTION.

14 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
 15 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF COMMUNICATION BOARDS REQUIRED UNDER
 16 THIS SUBTITLE IN PLAY AREAS UNDER A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY'S JURISDICTION
 17 SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2024.
