## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### $\mathbf{2}$ **Department of Veterans Affairs – Renaming and Deputy Secretary of Military** 3 **Family Policy and Programs**

4 FOR the purpose of renaming the Department of Veterans Affairs to be the Department of Veterans and Military Families; renaming the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to be  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 the Secretary of Veterans and Military Families; requiring the Secretary to appoint 7 a Deputy Secretary of Military Family Policy and Programs; providing that the 8 Department of Veterans and Military Families is the successor of the Department of 9 Veterans Affairs; requiring the publisher of the Annotated Code of Maryland, in 10 consultation with the Department of Legislative Services, to correct cross-references 11 and terminology in the Code that are rendered incorrect by this Act; and generally 12relating to the renaming of the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs. 13
