BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 14 Article - Health - General 15 [18–601.1. 16 An individual who has the human immunodeficiency virus may not knowingly 17 transfer or attempt to transfer the human immunodeficiency virus to another individual. 18 A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$2,500 or imprisonment not exceeding 19 20 3 years or both. 21SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024. 22
