- 2 (B) (1) EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT 3 A POLICY THAT AUTHORIZES A STUDENT TO WITHDRAW FOR EXTENUATING 4 CIRCUMSTANCES.
- 5 (2) THE POLICY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
  6 INCLUDE A PROVISION TO REIMBURSE A STUDENT FOR TUITION AND FEES PAID FOR
  7 THE SEMESTER IN WHICH THE STUDENT WITHDRAWS IF THE EXTENUATING
  8 CIRCUMSTANCES INHIBIT THE STUDENT'S ABILITY TO ACQUIRE AN EDUCATION AT
  9 THE PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS DEFINED IN POLICY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
